

## Graiglwyd Springs Fly Fishery

### Additional Rules due to Covid-19

Pre-booking will be required for all anglers, on our website or link on Facebook. [www.graiglwydsprings.co.uk](http://www.graiglwydsprings.co.uk)

4-hour sessions only during this time.

All anglers must park in the spaces indicated by parking cones, to ensure a safe distance.

All anglers must social distance and keep at least 2 metres away from others.

Before entering the Fishing Lodge to use the toilet, you must use the hand sanitiser provided and wash hands thoroughly, binning the paper towels. We will ensure the toilets are sanitised before and after use.

All fishing pegs are 15 metres apart. However, to get to each peg, follow the arrows on the ground to avoid close contact with others.

Food must be consumed either in your car, or on the bench at the peg. There will be no communal areas available on which to eat or drink.

All of your waste/rubbish/cigarette butts and line, must be bagged and taken home with you.

Our tea and coffee making facility will not be available at this time.

Only 1 person permitted in the Fishing Lodge at any time in addition to staff member.

On arrival please report to the Fishing Lodge.

Please do not arrive before the start time for your booking, as it may cause traffic congestion.

Our scales will not be available for weighing fish. If you wish to weigh your fish in the net, please bring your own scales.

We will ensure that our gates are open so you do not have to touch anything, and that our Net Dip tank is open too.

Please bring rubber gloves and hand sanitiser with you, and a mask if you have one available for your own and others' safety.

Pre order of Tackle or Flies is possible and these can be ready for you on arrival.

During this time, we cannot hire rods or nets, but they're available to purchase new.

Also, no lessons are available for now.

Payment must be by contactless card if on site, otherwise pre-booking via [PayPal](#) online.

If you are suffering from any symptoms of Covid -19 or have been in contact with somebody who has symptoms or is ill, please do not book or visit.
